


BALLOT MARKING INSTRUCTIONS:

a. With the marking device provided or a black ball point pen, completely fill in the oval  to the left of each candidate or selection of your choice, like this:



b. Where authorized, you may write in a candidate by filling in the oval and writing the name on the Write-in line.

c. If you tear, deface or wrongly mark this ballot, return it to request a replacement.

STRAIGHT PARTY VOTING

a. A Straight Party vote is a vote for all candidates of that party in PARTISAN OFFICES. It is not necessary to mark individual candidates for PARTISAN OFFICES if you vote Straight Party.

b. You may vote a Straight Party AND ALSO vote for a candidate of a different party in any individual office.

c. In any multi-seat office, a Straight Party vote is a vote for ALL candidates of that party. If you individually vote for any candidate in a multi-seat office, you must also individually mark all other candidates in that office for whom you wish to vote in order for all votes for that office to be counted.

d. If you do not vote a Straight Party below, you may vote by marking each office separately.

e. A Straight Party vote does not include unaffiliated candidates, nonpartisan offices, issues or referenda.
