**DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Hurricane Dorian has the potential to impact Carteret County, NC; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of the above described incident, I have determined that there is an imminent threat of, or existing conditions have caused or will cause, severe damage, flooding and significant impacts to our County.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners of Carteret County, under Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Chapter 5 of the Carteret County Code of Ordinances:

**Section 1-** A State of Emergency is hereby declared within the jurisdiction of Carteret County.

**Section 2-** I hereby order all County employees, County law enforcement officers, County Fire and EMS departments and emergency management personnel subject to our control to cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of the provisions of this Declaration, all applicable local ordinances, State and Federal laws, and the Carteret County Emergency Operations Plan.

**Section 3-** I hereby order this declaration: (a) to be distributed to the news media and other organizations calculated to bring its contents to the attention of the general public; (b) to be filed with Clerk to the Board of Commissioners and (c) to be distributed to others as necessary to ensure proper implementation of this declaration.

**Section 4-** At this time, no other restrictions are associated with this declaration.

**Section 5-** This declaration shall take effect on Tuesday, September 3, 2019 at 8:00 a.m., and shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded.
