Carteret County COVID-19 Two Confirmed COVID-19 Deaths Reported Press Release #118

Carteret County, NC – The Carteret County Health Department regrets to inform that the County received reports of two confirmed COVID-19 deaths of Carteret County residents. Both residents had pre-existing health conditions and died from complications associated with the COVID-19 virus. One resident was in their 60's and the other was in their 70's. To protect the privacy of the families, no further information about the residents will be released.

“We continue to see the spread of the COVID-19 virus in our community and sadly had two more residents pass,” stated Carteret County Consolidated Human Services Director, Cindy Holman. “I encourage everyone to get the vaccine to protect yourself and help protect your neighbors from contracting this deadly virus.”

Vaccination appointments are now open to all individuals 16 years of age or older. Individuals can call 252-728-8550 and select Option 2 between the hours of 8 am- 5 pm to schedule an available vaccination appointment. Walk ins are not available at clinics.
