WHEREAS, on September 15, 2023 Carteret County Attorney Claud Roberson Wheatly, III was inducted into the North Carolina Bar Association Legal Practice Hall of Fame Class of 2023 echoing his father C.R. Wheatly, Jr. who was inducted in 1989; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Wheatly was born and raised in Beaufort, graduated from Beaufort High School in 1965, graduated from The Citadel in 1969, and the University of South Carolina School of Law in 1972; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Wheatly served in the United States Army and was honorably discharged at the rank of Captain, and


WHEREAS, upon returning to Carteret County he began practicing law with his father in 1972, specializing in real property, estate planning, environmental law, civil law and everything in between; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Wheatly previously served as the Town Attorney for Beaufort before becoming the County Attorney, a position he has held for over thirty years; and
