Beaufort, North Carolina, March 12, 2019 – Carteret County lost a dedicated servant on Monday, March 11, 2019. Chief Adam Snyder, a member of the Atlantic Beach Fire Department for twenty years, died as a result of a skiing accident in Virginia.

Chief Snyder was a member of the Atlantic Beach Fire Department for twenty years, fifteen of those as Chief. Chief Snyder was also a United States Marine Corps veteran where he served as a Rescue Swimmer.

“Adam was the epitome of a true public servant. He dedicated his life – both while in the Marine Corps and during his time with the Atlantic Beach Fire Department, to helping and serving others. During and following Hurricane Florence this past fall, Adam showed his public servitude by assisting other municipalities and the County in our efforts to help those affected by the storm;” stated Mark Mansfield, Chairman of the Carteret County Board of Commissioners.
