- Well water sampling and analysis




ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES

- Follow-up on animal bite reports
- Arranges quarantine agreements
- Offers low-cost rabies, spay/neuter and microchipping clinics
- Enforces NC and county animal control laws, emphasizing rabies vaccination and county leash laws
- Prevents transmission of vector-borne diseases through education and awareness


